


Paint the chameleon

You will need:

- Chart paper cut into A4 size
- Black marker
- Paint
- Water
- Brush
- Palette

How to do:

- Make the story – The mixed up chameleon familiar to the child.
- Draw a chameleon using a black marker on the chart paper, similar to the chameleon in the story.
- Provide children the chart, paint and brush.
- Ask children to paint the chameleon using their favourite colours.
- Let it dry.
- Display every child's work in your classroom.

You will need:

- Chart paper
- Music player

How to do:

- Cut out tiny construction paper flowers and place them on the floor throughout the classroom.
- Give each child a butterfly.
- This game is played much like musical chairs but without competition.
- Switch on the music and ask children to fly around like butterflies while the music plays.
- When it stops, each "butterfly" must find the flower.
- Children who do not have a flower will be out of the game.
- Children can exchange their butterflies prior to the music starting up again.

You will need:

- Silk flowers/ Real flowers
- Fake or real plants
- Vases
- Pots or other containers
- Transparent crepe papers
- Paper Money

How to do :

- Encourage children to wrap the bouquets using flowers , plants and crepe papers.
- Also ask children to arrange flowers in few pots and vases.
- Now make a corner of the classroom as a flower shop.
- Let one child be the shop owner.
- Let rest of the children get a chance to buy the flowers they wish using the paper money they have.
- Encourage children to say the name of the flower they want to buy.

You will need:

- Apples
- Cream Cheese / whipped cream
- Food Coloring (optional)
- Sprinkles

How to do:

- Slice your apples about 3/4" thick. Use a knife, corer, or pastry tip to make a hole in the center.
- Colour your cream cheese if you like. Just add a drop of neon / any food colouring to get bright colors.
- Add sprinkles.
- Enjoy this healthier "donut" for kids that makes a yummy and adorable snack.
